Brook Street is a six bedroomed, wheelchair accessible residence providing a home from home living experience for people that stay with us. It also benefits from two living rooms for socialising and a bright and airy dining room and kitchen for sharing meals in.

WHAT IS THE SERVICE AND WHO IS IT FOR?

Brook Street provides a range of services for people with learning disability aged 18+ living in the Bexley area.

The residence, its ground floor bedrooms and its garden are fully wheelchair accessible meaning we can support people who may also **have a physical disability.**

We are also able to support the transition of people from youth to adult services.



HOW IS SUPPORT PROVIDED?

The Ambient Way means our team work in partnership with the people that use the service, their families and friends so that individuals are supported in a way that is right for them. This means we operate a flexible person-centred approach to care and care-planning.

Our friendly and experienced staff are able to support the people that use our services and their families 24/7, either in Brook Street, in their own homes or whilst out in the community.

AT BROOK STREET WE CAN OFFER PEOPLE

- **FLEXIBLE RESIDENTIAL SHORT BREAKS**
From a single night through to a weekend and up to whole weeks stay.
- **A RANGE OF SPECIAL THEMED RESIDENTIAL WEEKEND AND WEEK-LONG BREAKS**
Geared toward either younger or older people with events and activities to suit.
- **ACCOMPANYING SUPPORT**
That enables people to holiday independently.
- **AN OUTREACH SERVICE**
Supporting people in their own homes and whilst out and about in the community.
